

RMGC Policies & Procedures

Policy #1: Visiting Clubs and Societies.

A. General.

The RMGC is often approached by golf clubs and societies for a team from the Club to play golf fixtures against them. e.g. teams from visiting Navy vessels or from Royal Golf Clubs. Such fixtures promote the Club's name and encourage golfers to visit Malta and the Club. This is encouraged so long as it does not unduly impact members' access to the course and is revenue generating for the Club. Such fixtures (limited in number) may only be approved by the BOM.

B. Home Matches

Visiting teams and societies will be offered courtesy of the course for a match against the RMGC. Visitors will only be charged for equipment hire. Visitors playing additional rounds will be charged the rate of the day for their green fees. British Service Personnel will enjoy the Members Guest rate of the day for their rounds. Where a reciprocal agreement is in place, the terms and conditions of that agreement will prevail.

The RMGC team will be selected by the Club Captain. Where appropriate, a list is to be placed on the notice board for those who have an interest in playing to sign up for possible selection.

Where refreshments are to be provided for the visitors by the RMGC, these must be covered by a match fee which must be published on the sign-up sheet.

An appropriate memento may be purchased by the Captain, from general RMGC funds, for presentation to the visiting club/society after the match.

C. Away matches

The RMGC team will be selected by the Club Captain. Where appropriate, a list is to be placed on the notice board for those who have an interest in playing to sign up for possible selection. Wherever possible, an approximate budget for the overall trip shall be published on the sign-up sheet. Participation will be at the sole expense of those chosen to travel and play.

An appropriate memento may be purchased by the individual acting as captain of the RMGC team, from general RMGC funds, for presentation to the host club after the match.

D. Representations

Where Club officials are invited to represent the RMGC overseas, those chosen to travel will do so solely at their own expense. The decision on who attends on behalf of the RMGC lies with the BOM, who would ordinarily offer first option to the Club Captain. An appropriate memento may be purchased by the attendees, from general RMGC funds, for presentation to the hosts.

E. General

Under no circumstances are members funds, held in escrow, to be utilised for any of the above.
