### **RMGC Policies & Procedures**

### Policy #24: COVID Precautions:

#### If you appear to have COVID-19 symptoms:

Call 111 if you appear to have COVID-19 symptoms and follow the advice given. You will be advised whether you need a test or should isolate.

# If you have come into contact with a COVID-19 Positive person:

Persons identified by the public health authorities as close contacts of confirmed cases and who do not live with confirmed cases will be put under mandatory quarantine for 14 days from the last day of contact with the person who tested positive, provided they do not develop any symptoms related to Covid-19. This is enforceable by law.

Contact, in golf terms, means if you have played golf with, shared an after game drink with, or come into close contact with someone who has subsequently tested positive, you should call 111 immediately and follow the advice you are given.
